There's a light at the end of the tunnel! The latest decrees from the North-Rhine Westphalia Government also permit educational establishments, including your painting school, to re-open on condition that it is guaranteed that a minimum distance of 1.50 metres is maintained.

We had already been considering in the run-up to this happening how this can work in the painting school. Since in any case our groups are only small, it will be possible to keep to the distance regulations that have been imposed. Should it turn out that a group is too big, the instructors will discuss with the parents about splitting it into two.

We are proposing that children should only be brought as far as the entrance to the school. This is intended to minimise contacts as far as possible. The instructor will collect your children at the door. For hygienic reasons, each child will have to bring along a (small) personal hand towel. This is because it will be necessary for them to wash their hands frequently. Disinfectant will also be available, and masks in a variety of sizes can be provided where they may be needed.

The passage through to the area where the adults are taught will be closed off for the time being. The instructor will be contacting parents in the next few days to discuss what to do with the group of small children that meets on Thursdays.

As soon as the new measures are up and running, we will be in touch with you to make arrangements to cover for the lessons that were cancelled in recent weeks.
